If you pay directly to Lifegate you will receive an invoice and a carbon offsetting certificate. LifeGate will email you back your personalized digital carbon offsetting certificate. This payment should be made by the 10th of January 2026 and proof of payment provided at the reception of the Maloja Palace hotel to attend the dinner. **CHF30** for the dinner should be paid upon arrival at the Maloja Palace. The drinks during the dinner and cocktail will be offered by the host or a possible sponsor.

There will be a possibility of paying the entire amount of **CHF200** at the Maloja Palace which will transfer **CHF170** to LifeGate that will invoice all the amount to me.
